IMPORTANT UPDATE - APRIL 2015:

Current Vietjet policy is for potential flight crew, including those eligible for upgrade to Captain, to pay cash up front for "training". This amount ranges from \$25,000 USD up to and over \$65,000. The amount does **not** include any associated fees incurred by CAAV for licence processing fee.

Advice from pilots within Vietjet is to be wary of working for this airline - as it is plainly clear most of the money goes straight to certain individuals in the company. In addition, the last round of cadets were kept waiting over 12 months and at present are still receiving no salary - instead continuing with only observation rides to save the company money (once certified, they would have to be paid, so are kept on indefinite training).

The treatment of current pilots and their method of flight crew recruitment is an absolute disgrace and blight upon the industry.
